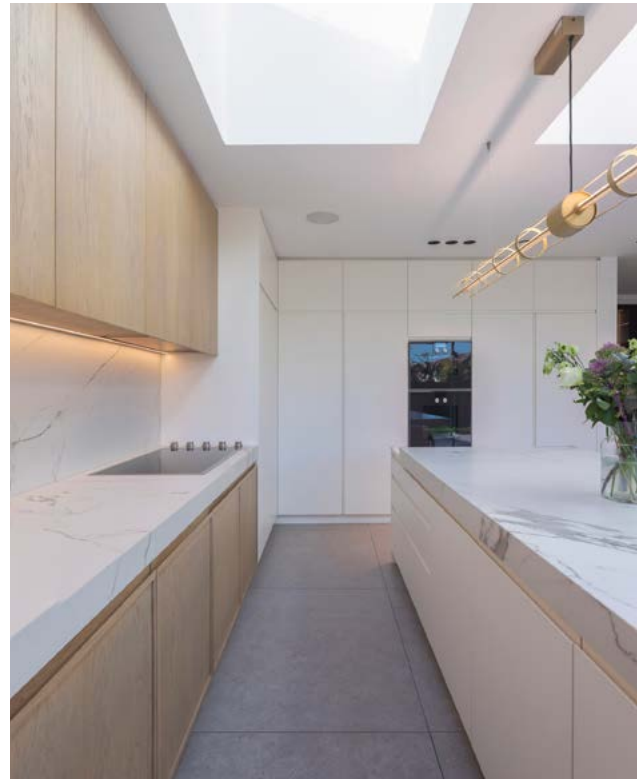

## HOLBORN

The project consisted of a full structural renovation of this prestigious five storey plus lower ground imposing building in Bloomsbury. Every part, except for the listed front façade, was renovated to an exacting standard with a challenging spine construction and staircase design. The works involved the demolishing of an outdated single storey rear extension which we replaced with a spectacular new side and rear extensions complete with two contemporary modern courtyards for family enjoyment. Microcement was used throughout.

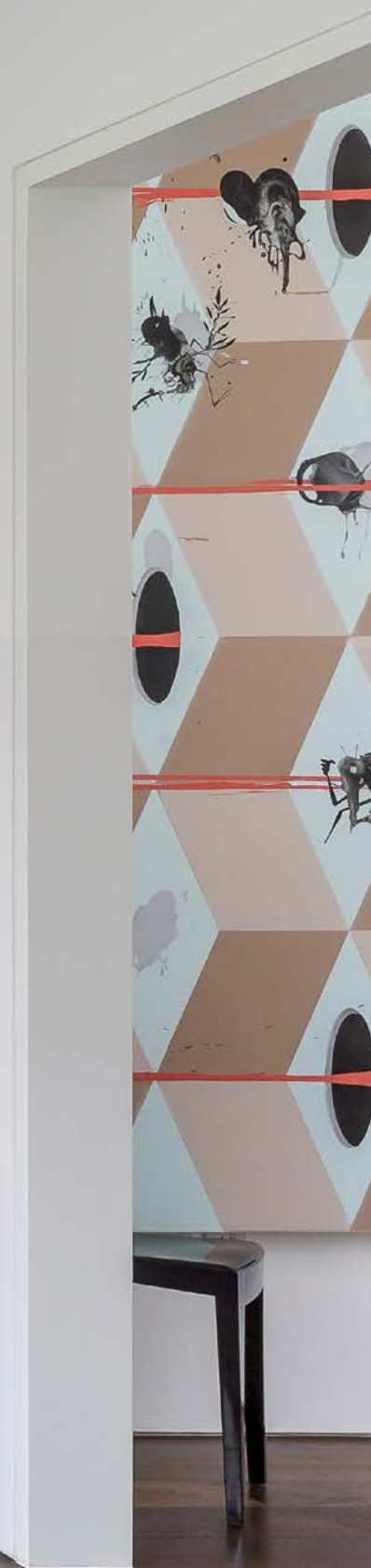

## WANDSWORTH HOUSE

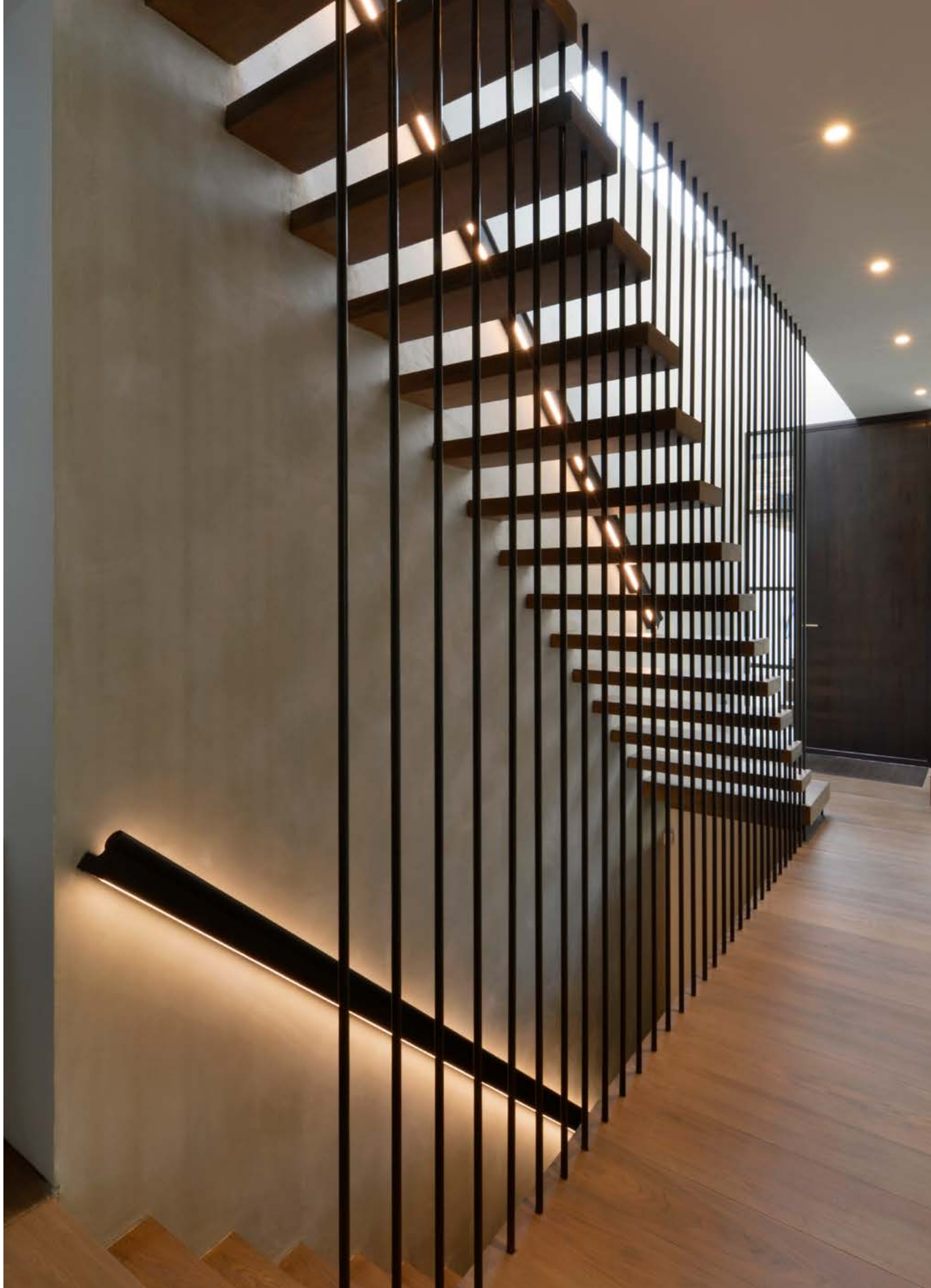
























## FULHAM II

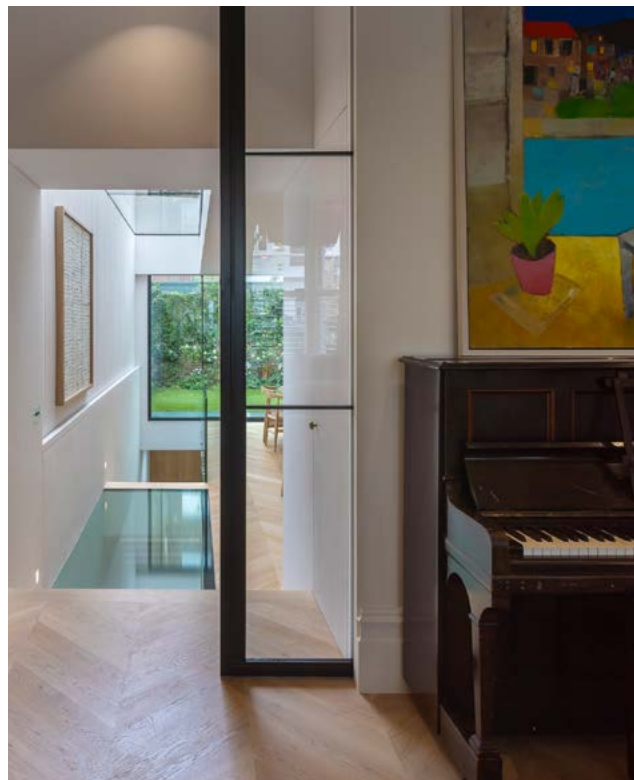
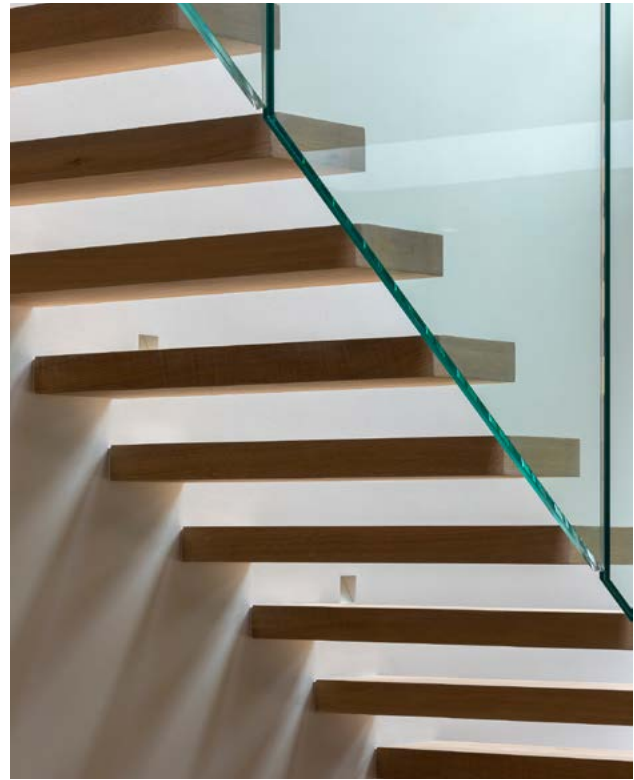
























## CAMBERWELL

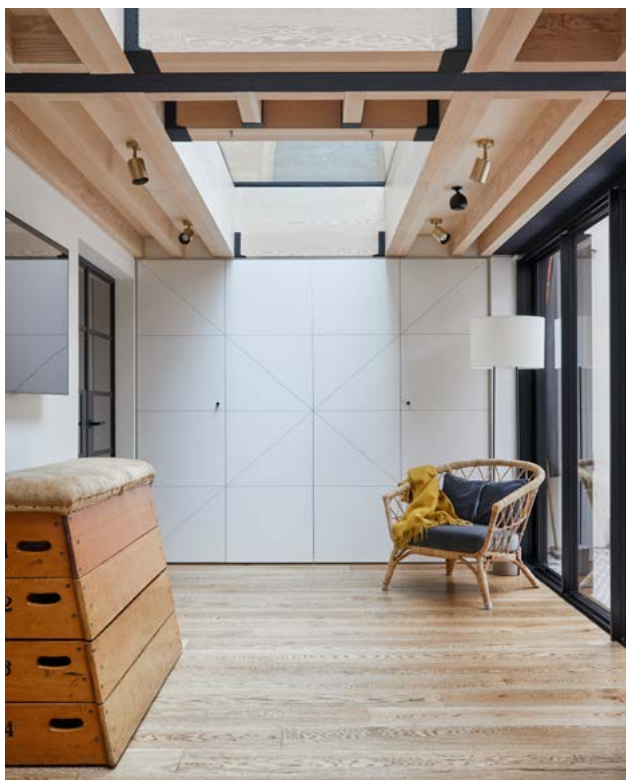

## NETHERHALL

This RIBA award-winning new build is a six-bedroom home over two storeys plus basement, combining modern and vernacular detailing with exceptional craftsmanship. The ground floor is designed for family living, centred around a brick structure with open fire, and filled with natural light from sash windows, a courtyard, and rear garden glazing. The upper floors include a dramatic pitched-ceiling master suite with terrace, while the basement houses a cinema room, playroom, wine store and utility spaces. Rich, tactile materials; re-sawn oak, Douglas fir, handmade tiles bring warmth and historic resonance to this contemporary home.

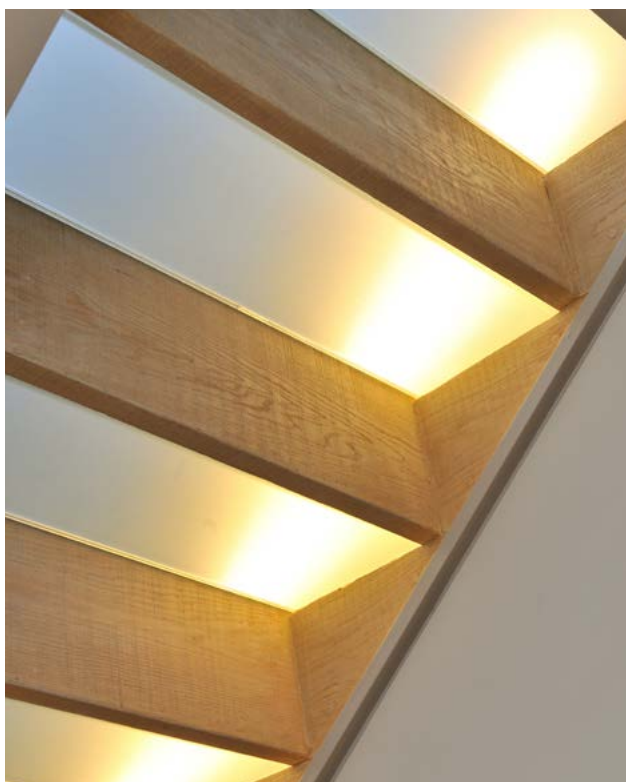

## CLAPHAM

This project involved the full classical renovation of a period property, with a new single-storey extension featuring plaster and stone pilasters designed to reflect the original architecture. The stucco façades were carefully restored, while the interiors were upgraded with hand-made bathroom tiles and refurbished Victorian pine floorboards, preserving the home's historic character. Reclaimed Yorkstone was used extensively across external areas, chosen for its aged texture and authenticity. Distorted 'Goethe' period glass was installed throughout, adding a subtle historic quality to the glazing and reinforcing the home's timeless aesthetic.
